**AND UPON** reading the Secretary of State for Business, Enterprise and Regulatory Reform's ("Secretary of State") application of 22 October 2008 for a direction of the Tribunal pursuant to rule 19(2)(h) of the Competition Appeal Tribunal Rules 2003 (S.I. No. 1372 of 2003) (the "Tribunal Rules") that the parties have one month from the date of notification of the Tribunal's decision on further relief in which to request permission to appeal any aspect of the Tribunal's decisions in relation to Case 1096/4/8/08

**AND UPON** reading the Secretary of State's application, in the alternative, for an extension of time to request permission to appeal from the Judgment to one month from the date of notification of the Tribunal's decision on relief pursuant to rule 19(2)(i) of the Tribunal Rules

**AND UPON** reading British Sky Broadcasting Group plc's application of 22 October 2008 for a direction of the Tribunal pursuant to either rule 19(2)(h) or rule 19(2)(i) of the Tribunal Rules in relation to Case 1095/4/8/08

**AND HAVING REGARD** to the public interest in securing the just, expeditious and economical conduct of these proceedings pursuant to rule 19(1) of the Tribunal Rules

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The time for making a request to the Tribunal for permission to appeal from the Judgment be extended until one month from the notification of the Tribunal's decision on further relief
