**ORDER**

**UPON** considering the Tribunal's Order of 16 December 2009 establishing the procedural timetable for these proceedings

**AND UPON** the Tribunal Registry writing to the parties in relation to that timetable on 29 January 2010

**AND UPON** considering the observations of the Respondent and the Interveners on this issue

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The timetable established by the Tribunal's Order of 16 December 2009 be varied as follows:

- (d) The Appellant file and serve its skeleton argument, incorporating any points in Reply, on the non-price control matters by 5pm on 8 March 2010
- (e) British Sky Broadcasting Limited, if so advised, file and serve its skeleton argument on the non-price control matters by 5pm on 12 March 2010
- (f) The Respondent and, if so advised, British Telecommunications plc file and serve their respective skeleton arguments on the non-price control matters by 5pm on 18 March 2010
- (g) The parties file six copies of the agreed bundle of documents and bundle of authorities by 5pm on 19 March 2010, but avoiding duplication so far as possible with documents already lodged with the Tribunal.
