ORDER

UPON British Telecommunications plc (“BT”) applying, in its Notice of Appeal dated 1 June 2012, for a stay of this appeal pending determination by the Court of Appeal of the appeal against the Tribunal’s judgment in Cases 1151-, 1168- and 1169/3/3/10 ([2011] CAT 24) (the “08x Appeal”), and there being no objection to that application

AND UPON Vodafone Limited (“Vodafone”) applying, by way of an application dated 20 June 2012, for permission to intervene in this appeal

AND UPON the Office of Communications (“OFCOM”) supporting Vodafone’s application and there being no objection to it by BT

AND HAVING REGARD TO the Tribunal’s case management powers under rule 19(1) of the Competition Appeal Tribunal Rules (S.I. No. 1372 of 2003)

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Vodafone be granted permission to intervene in this appeal.

2. The proceeding be stayed until the date falling 14 days after the Court of Appeal hands down its judgment in the 08x Appeal.
3. There be liberty to apply.
