ORDER

UPON reading the submissions of the parties

AND UPON hearing counsel for the parties at a hearing on 1 November 2005

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The respondent shall pay 92.5% of the appellants' costs of the appeal (excluding the costs of the costs application) in case 1035/1/1/04, the amount of such costs to be agreed between the respondent and the appellant.
2. If no agreement has been reached within 28 days of the date of this order the respondent will pay forthwith, on account, 50% of the total sum of the appellants' costs bill (as calculated in accordance with paragraph 1 above) and the appellants' costs will be subject to the detailed assessment on the standard basis of a costs officer of the Supreme Court.

3. The respondent shall pay the appellants £15,929.45 in full and final settlement of the appellants' costs of the costs application within 28 days of the date of this order.
