# **ORDER**

**UPON** reading the decision of the Office of Fair Trading ("OFT") dated 22 October

2009 entitled "Response to CAMRA's Super-complaint"

**AND UPON** reading the Notice of Application lodged by the Campaign for Real Ale ("CAMRA") under Rules 8 and 25 of The Competition Appeal Tribunal Rules 2003 (S.I. No. 1372 of 2003) on 22 December 2009
