#### **ORDER**

**UPON** British Telecommunications plc ("BT") applying, in its Notice of Appeal dated 1 June 2012, for a stay of this appeal pending determination by the Court of Appeal of the appeal against the Tribunal's judgment in Cases 1151-, 1168- and 1169/3/3/10 ([2011] CAT 24) (the "08x Appeal"), and there being no objection to that application

**AND UPON** Vodafone Limited ("Vodafone") applying, by way of an application dated 20 June 2012, for permission to intervene in this appeal

**AND UPON** the Office of Communications ("OFCOM") supporting Vodafone's application and there being no objection to it by BT

**AND HAVING REGARD TO** the Tribunal's case management powers under rule 19(1) of the Competition Appeal Tribunal Rules (S.I. No. 1372 of 2003)

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Vodafone be granted permission to intervene in this appeal.

- 2. The proceeding be stayed until the date falling 14 days after the Court of Appeal hands down its judgment in the 08x Appeal.
- 3. There be liberty to apply.
