ORDER OF THE CHAIRMAN (EXTENDING STAY TO PROCEEDINGS)

UPON considering the Tribunal's Order of 6 July 2012 staying these proceedings

AND UPON the Court of Appeal handing down its judgment on 25 July 2012 in *BT v Ofcom and others* [2012] EWCA Civ 1002 ("the 08x Judgment")

AND UPON reading the letter from the Appellant dated 5 September 2012 requesting a further stay of these proceedings, on account of the Appellant's application of 22 August 2012 to the Supreme Court for permission to appeal the 08x Judgment ("the Permission Application")

AND UPON the Respondent and Intervener agreeing to that request

AND HAVING REGARD TO the Tribunal's case management powers under rule 19(1) of the Competition Appeal Tribunal Rules (S.I. No. 1372 of 2003)

IT IS ORDERED BY CONSENT THAT:

- 1. These proceedings be stayed until:
 - a. if the Permission Application is refused, five working days after the Supreme Court determines the Permission Application; or
 - b. if the Permission Application is granted, five working days after the Supreme Court hands down judgment in the appeal.
- 2. There be liberty to apply.
