UPON the Ruling in these proceedings of 26 July 2017 ([2017] CAT 17) (the "Tribunal's Ruling")

AND UPON the Tribunal handing down its reasoned judgment in respect of these proceedings on 10 November 2017 ([2017] CAT 25) (the "Tribunal's Judgment")

AND UPON considering the terms of a draft order filed by the Respondent on 16 November 2017

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Those decisions of the Respondent contained in the statement dated 28 April 2016 entitled "Business Connectivity Market Review" (the "Statement") that are referred to in Schedule A to this Order (the "Identified Decisions") be quashed. The Respondent shall revoke any instruments giving effect to the Identified Decisions by the date 7 days after the making of this Order.
- By virtue of the revocation directed in paragraph 1 above, the Directions that are referred to in 2. Schedule B to this Order shall be quashed to the extent that they apply to the following markets:
