ORDER (CONTINUATION OF STAY)

UPON the Court of Appeal handing down its judgment in case number C3/2014/4185 on 4 May 2017 ([2017] EWCA Civ 330)

AND UPON considering the request by the Appellant for an extension to the stay of these proceedings ordered on 13 August 2014 and 24 November 2015 and there being no objection to that request by the Respondent or the Potential Intervener

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The stay in these proceedings continue until either: (i) five working days after

the period for an application for permission to appeal expires or (ii) if an application for permission to appeal is made to the Supreme Court, five working days after such application is decided

- 2. Interested parties be allowed ten working days following the lifting of the stay to request permission to intervene
- 3. There be liberty to apply
