ORDER

HAVING REGARD TO the Tribunal's Order dated 25 April 2019 (the "Further Directions Order")

AND HAVING REGARD TO the Tribunal's case management powers under Rule 53 of the Competition Appeal Tribunal Rules 2015

AND UPON the Defendant applying by letter dated 6 June 2019 for permission to vary the Further Directions Order ("the Application")

AND UPON the Claimant having consented to the Application

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Paragraph 13 of the Further Directions Order is varied such that the deadline for the parties to file and serve the expert reports of their expert witnesses on the question of a bird park (the "Bird Park Experts") be extended until 4pm on 13 June 2019.
- 2. Paragraph 14 of the Further Directions Order is varied such that the Bird Park Experts are to meet for without prejudice discussions without the presence of the parties or their legal advisers between 14 to 25 June 2019 and the deadline for the parties' Bird Park Experts to produce and file a joint statement indicating points agreed and not agreed with concise reasons for any disagreement be extended until 4pm on 26 June 2019.

- 3. Costs in the case.
- 4. There be liberty to apply.
