AND HAVING REGARD TO the Consent Order drawn on 9 March 2020 ordering that Volvo/Renault's disclosure of the documents referred to in paragraphs 10, 11 and 12 of the Disclosure Order be extended to 30 April 2020

AND UPON the application by Volvo/Renault by their solicitors' letter dated 22 April 2020 further to extend the time by reason of the difficulties caused by the Covid-19 pandemic, which application is agreed to by the Claimants

BY CONSENT IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- The time for Volvo/Renault's disclosure of the documents referred to in paragraph 10 of the Disclosure Order be extended to 4 June 2020.
- 2. The time for Volvo/Renault's disclosure of the documents referred to in paragraph 11 of the Disclosure Order be extended to 4 June 2020.
- 3. The time for Volvo/Renault to provide the description referred to in paragraph 12 of the Disclosure Order be extended to 4 June 2020.
- 4. Costs in the case.
- 5. There be liberty to apply.
