#### **ORDER**

**UPON** reading the notice of application lodged by the Applicant under rules 9 and 26 of the Competition Appeal Tribunal Rules 2015 (S.I. No. 1648 of 2015) ("the Tribunal Rules") on 17 June 2020 ("the Application")

**AND UPON** reading the request by Frasers Group Plc ("Frasers Group") for permission to intervene under Rule 16 of the Tribunal Rules in support of the Respondent

**AND UPON** reading the submissions of the parties and Frasers Group filed in advance of a case management conference ("CMC") on 6 July 2020

**AND UPON** hearing Counsel for the parties and Frasers Group at the CMC held remotely on 6 July 2020

#### IT IS ORDERED THAT:

## Forum

1. The Application be treated as proceedings in England and Wales for the purposes of Rule 18 of the Tribunal Rules.

### Intervention

2. Fraser Group's request for permission to intervene be refused.

## **Confidentiality**

3. A confidentiality ring be established by separate order in the terms agreed by the parties.

### **Disclosure**

- 4. The CMA shall disclose into the confidentiality ring any "duty of candour" material and a version of the Final Report that is unredacted as regards the paragraphs that are relevant to the areas in dispute in the application by 5pm on 24 July 2020.
- 5. JD Sports shall, if so advised, file any application for specific disclosure by 5pm on 31 July 2020.
- 6. The CMA shall provide its written response to any application for specific disclosure by 5pm on 7 August 2020.

## **Future conduct of the Application**

- 7. The CMA shall file its Defence and any supporting witness evidence by 5pm on 16 July 2020.
- 8. JD Sports shall file its Reply, if so advised, by 5pm on 11 September 2020.
- 9. JD Sports shall file its skeleton argument by 5pm on 11 September 2020.
- 10. JD Sports shall lodge an agreed bundle for the hearing by 5pm on 15 September 2020.
- 11. The CMA shall file its skeleton argument by 5pm on 18 September 2020.

- 12. The skeleton arguments shall not exceed 25 pages in length in normal format and spacing.
- 13. JD Sports shall lodge an agreed bundle of authorities by 5pm on 18 September 2020.
- 14. A hearing be listed for 23 September 2020 with a time estimate of 2 days.

# General

- 15. Costs in the case.
- 16. There be liberty to apply.
