## **CONSENT ORDER**

**UPON** the Claimants and First to Sixth Defendants (the "**DAF Defendants**") agreeing to extend to 14 August 2020 the deadline for the filing and service of the DAF Defendants' Defence;

**AND UPON** that agreement being conditional on the extension not delaying the transfer of these proceedings to the Competition Appeal Tribunal (the "**Tribunal**"), provided for under the order of Master Clark made on 2 March 2020 (the "**Transfer Order**");

**AND UPON** paragraph 2 of the Transfer Order providing that the Claim shall be transferred to the Tribunal "upon the earlier of: (a) the service and filing of any Replies; or (b) 28 days following the service and filing of Defences."

## **BY CONSENT IT IS ORDERED THAT:**



- 1. The time for the DAF Defendants to file and serve a Defence to the Claim be extended to 14 August 2020.
- 2. Paragraph 2 of the Transfer Order be varied so that it reads: "The provisions at paragraph 1 of this order shall take effect on 7 August 2020".
- 3. Costs in the case.
- 4. The DAF Defendants shall serve this order on the parties.
