ORDER

BY CONSENT IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Pursuant to Rule 53 of the CAT Rules, the Visa Defendants shall have permission to

file and serve an amended Defence in the form included at Annex 1 to this Order,

within 7 days of the date of this Order.

2. Pursuant to Rule 53 of the CAT Rules, the Mastercard Defendants shall have

permission to file and serve an amended Defence in the form included at Annex 2 to

this Order, within 7 days of the date of this Order.

3. The Claimants shall have permission to file and serve any consequential amendments

to their Reply, within 28 days of the date of this Order.

4. The Defendants shall not be required to comply with Rules 35(3) and (4) of the CAT

Rules in respect of their amended Defences.

5. Costs of the amendments to the Visa Defendants' Defence and reasonable costs of the

Claimants occasioned by such amendments shall be borne by the Visa Defendants.

6. Costs of the amendments to the Mastercard Defendants' Defence and reasonable costs

of the Claimants occasioned by such amendments shall be borne by the Mastercard

Defendants.

7. Liberty to apply.
