CONSENT ORDER

UPON the Class Representative's application for a Collective Proceedings Order pursuant to section 47B of the Competition Act 1998 and Rule 75 of the Competition Appeal Tribunal Rules 2015 (the "**CPO Application**") being filed on 28 July 2021.

AND UPON hearing from the Class Representative's counsel at the hearing on 18 July 2022.

AND UPON the Tribunal handing down judgment on 31 August 2022 granting the CPO Application.

AND UPON the Tribunal having ordered on 9 September 2022 that the costs of the CPO Application shall be determined by the Tribunal on the papers.

AND UPON the Class Representative and Defendants having agreed to the making of this order.

BY CONSENT IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Defendants shall pay the Class Representative the Class Representative's costs of and occasioned by the Defendants' opposition to the CPO Application between (and inclusive of) 14 February 2022 to 22 June 2022, such costs to be subject to detailed assessment on the standard basis, if not agreed (the "**CPO costs**").
2. The Defendants shall make an interim payment on account of the CPO costs, in the sum of £165,000 (inclusive of VAT), within 28 days of this Order.
3. The costs incurred by the Class Representative: (a) in the periods prior to 14 February 2022 and after 22 June 2022; and (b) during the period of 14 February 2022 to 22 June 2022 that are not CPO costs, shall be costs in the case.
