CONSENT ORDER

UPON the Tribunal handing down its judgment of 7 February 2023 ([2023] CAT 6) (the "**Judgment**")

AND UPON considering the terms of the Judgment, which should be read together with this Order

AND UPON the parties agreeing the terms of this Order

AND UPON the following definitions applying for the purposes of this Order:

- "Business Day" means a day other than a Saturday, Sunday, bank holiday or public holiday in the United Kingdom
- "Overcharge" has the meaning given at paragraph 2 of the Judgment for the purposes of this Order

IT IS ORDERED BY CONSENT THAT:

Damages and interest awards

- 1. The Defendants shall, within 10 Business Days of this Order, pay the Claimants:
 - (a) damages in the sum of £1,974,068 in respect of the Claimants' claim for Overcharge losses;
 - (b) interest in the sum of £1,461,696 in respect of the Claimants' claim for simple interest (calculated to 7 February 2023); and
 - (c) simple interest, calculated on a daily basis, on the sums awarded under paragraphs (a) and (b) of paragraph 1 of this Order at an interest rate calculated as the Bank of England Base Rate (currently 4%) plus 2% (i.e. an interest rate of 6% at the time of making this Order), per annum, for the period from 8 February 2023 to the date of this Order.
- 2. Any judgment debt arising in relation to the sums awarded under paragraph 1 of this Order (by way of damages and interest) shall carry daily interest at the per annum rate stipulated by section 17 of the Judgments Act 1838 (as amended) from the date of this Order until the date of final payment.

Costs

3. Costs reserved to the Tribunal pending its determination of applications consequential on the Judgment pursuant to the Chair's directions of 24 February 2023.

Other

4. There be liberty to apply.
