**UPON** the parties' agreement to extend the time for disclosure set forth in the directions order of Mr Justice Butcher of 5 July 2022 (as amended) (the **Directions Order**)

**IT IS ORDERED BY CONSENT THAT:**

1. The Directions Order be varied as follows:
  - (a) Paragraph 6 shall read "The parties shall exchange their lists for disclosure by list by 4pm on 24 March 2023. The parties' disclosure by list shall be accompanied by a disclosure statement in accordance with CPR Rule 31.10(5)-(7), and (9)."
  - (b) Paragraph 7 shall read "Requests for inspection of documents disclosed above shall be made by 4pm on 31 March 2023. Copies of documents requested to be inspected shall be provided within 7 days of the making of the request."

- (c) Paragraph 9 shall read, “By 4pm on 16 June 2023, the parties shall exchange and file:
  - (i) signed statements of witnesses of fact on the issues to be considered at the preliminary issues hearing; and
  - (ii) signed expert reports in the area of mineral supply chains, on the issues to be considered at the preliminary issues hearing.”
- (d) Paragraph 10 shall read, “By 4pm on 14 July 2023, the parties shall exchange and file signed reply witness statements, if any.”
- (e) Paragraph 11 shall read, “By 4pm on 28 July 2023, the parties shall exchange and file signed reply reports from the experts on mineral supply chains, if any.”
- (f) Paragraph 8A shall read, “Unless the Claimant serves its list of documents by 4pm on 24 March 2023 the claim will be struck out and judgment entered for the Defendant with costs to be assessed if they are not agreed.

2. No order as to costs.
