IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. HOME OFFICE REQUEST FOR PERMISSION TO INTERVENE

1. The Home Office is granted permission to intervene.
2. The Home Office shall file and serve its Statement of Intervention by 12pm on Monday, 10 July 2023.

2. SUBSTANTIVE HEARING OF THE APPLICATION

3. The Respondent will file and serve its Defence by 5pm on Monday, 3 July 2023.
4. The Applicants will file and serve their skeleton argument (and Reply and/or response to the Statement of Intervention, if so advised) by 5pm on Friday, 21 July 2023.
5. The Respondent and Home Office will file and serve their skeleton arguments by 5pm on Friday 28 July 2023.
6. The parties will file an agreed electronic bundle (in pdf form, indexed, bookmarked, paginated and fully searchable) and five hard copies of the bundle with the Tribunal by 10 am on Monday 31 July 2023; and
7. The hearing will take place on Wednesday and Thursday, 2 and 3 August 2023.

9. There shall be liberty to apply.
