## **ORDER (DIRECTIONS)**

**UPON** the Competition Appeal Tribunal (the "**Tribunal**") on 25 July 2022 granting the Class Representative's application for a collective proceedings order pursuant to section 47B of the Competition Act 1998 and Rule 75 of the Competition Appeal Tribunal Rules 2015 (S.I. 2015 No. 1648)

**AND UPON** the Tribunal having made a collective proceedings order on 5 October 2022

**AND UPON** hearing Counsel for the Parties at a case management conference on 17 March 2023

**AND UPON** the filing by the Class Representative of a proposed Re-Re-Amended Claim Form, a revised Costs Budget and the Second Expert Report of Dr Davis on 19 May 2023

**AND UPON** the letter from the Tribunal dated 24 May 2023 vacating the case management conference scheduled for 30 May 2023 and requesting the Parties liaise to agree a timetable for the future conduct of the proceedings

AND UPON reading the correspondence from the Parties' solicitors

#### IT IS ORDERED THAT:

#### **Timetable**

- 1. The Defendants shall file and serve any applications arising out of the proposed Re-Re-Amended Claim Form and the Second Expert Report of Dr Davis by 4pm on 28 July 2023.
- 2. The Class Representative and the Intervener shall file and serve any response to any applications made by the Defendants, if so advised, by 4pm on 8 September 2023.
- 3. The Defendants shall file and serve a Reply, if so advised, by 4pm on 29 September 2023.
- 4. A case management conference shall be listed on 12 October 2023, with a time estimate of two days (the "CMC").
- 5. The Parties shall file an agreed agenda for the CMC by 4pm on 2 October 2023.
- 6. The Parties shall file five hard copies and an electronic version of an agreed bundle (and an authorities bundle) for use at the CMC by 4pm on 6 October 2023.
- 7. The Parties shall file skeleton arguments for use at the CMC in Word format, with a maximum limit of 20 pages per party (1.5 spacing, 12-point font and regular margins) by 4pm on 9 October 2023.
