**ORDER**

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**UPON** the application by all parties to the VSW Proceedings, with the exception of the DAF Defendants (as defined below), (the “**Parties**”) dated 11 April 2023

**AND UPON** the Parties having agreed the terms of this Order

**AND UPON** the President of the Competition Appeal Tribunal having issued a request for international judicial assistance on 31 March 2023 (the ***Request for Assistance***) to the French Ministère de la Justice pursuant to Article 17 of the Hague Convention of 18 March 1970 on the Taking of Evidence Abroad in Civil or Commercial Matters (the ***Hague Convention***) in connection with the VSW Proceedings

**AND UPON** the President of the Competition Appeal Tribunal having ordered on 31 March 2023 (the ***31 March Order***) that Mr Alexander Blumrosen (the ***Commissioner***) of Polaris Law be appointed as Commissioner, pending the approval of the Ministère de la Justice, to take the evidence (and, if applicable, any reply evidence) of the witnesses who are located in France or are French citizens in aid of the VSW Proceedings (the ***French Factual Witnesses***)

**AND UPON** the Claimants' French Factual Witnesses being listed at confidential Annex 1 of the 31 March Order and the Defendants' French Factual Witnesses being listed at confidential Annex 2 of the 31 March Order

**AND UPON** the Iveco Defendants seeking to adduce evidence from further French Factual Witnesses (in addition to those listed at Annex 2 of the 31 March Order) as listed in confidential Annex 1 to this Order (the ***Additional Iveco French Factual Witnesses***)

**AND UPON** the following definitions applying for the purpose of this Order:

- “**DAF Defendants**” means PACCAR Inc, DAF Trucks N.V., DAF Trucks Deutschland GmbH and DAF Trucks Limited.
- “**Daimler Defendant**” means the Tenth Named Third Party in Case 1294/5/7/18.
- “**Iveco Defendants**” means Iveco SPA, Iveco Magirus AG, Stellantis NV and CNH Industrial NV.

- “**MAN Defendants**” means TRATON SE, MAN Truck & Bus SE, MAN Truck & Bus Deutschland GmbH and MAN Truck and Bus UK Limited.
- “**Scania Defendants**” means Scania Aktiebolag (publ), Scania CV Aktiebolag (publ) and Scania Deutschland GmbH.
- “**Volvo/Renault Defendants**” means Aktiebolaget Volvo (Publ), Volvo Lastvagnar Aktiebolag, Volvo Group Trucks Central Europe GMBH, Renault Trucks SAS and Renault Truck Commercials Limited.
- “**Claimants**” means the Claimants in the VSW Proceedings.

**BY CONSENT IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Iveco Defendants shall:
  - (a) provide the Commissioner with the signed Consent Order, who will arrange for a translation of the Consent Order into French; and
  - (b) provide the Commissioner with the names of the Additional Iveco French Factual Witnesses under confidential cover.
2. The terms of the Request for Assistance, including but not limited to paragraphs 11 and 14, shall apply to the Additional Iveco French Factual Witnesses *mutatis mutandis*.
3. The directions set out in paragraphs 1 to 9 of the 31 March Order shall apply to the Additional Iveco French Factual Witnesses *mutatis mutandis*.
4. Costs of this Application shall be in the case.
