AND UPON the Tribunal issuing its judgment on the Application on 27 July 2023 ([2023] CAT 50)

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Application is dismissed.

(b) Failing agreement, file and exchange written submissions as to the appropriate

form of order addressing matters consequential on the Order at paragraph 1

above. In such case, the Tribunal shall determine the appropriate form of order

on the papers.

3. Any consequential applications (including costs and any applications(s) for permission

to appeal pursuant to Rule 107 of the Tribunal Rules) be filed and served by 5pm on 8

September 2023.

4. Any responsive submissions be filed and served by 5pm on 13 September 2023.

5. Any appellant's notice be filed at the Court of Appeal within 14 days of the Tribunal's

decision on permission to appeal.
