**ORDER**

**UPON** the Order of the Tribunal made on 6 April 2023 (the “**Directions to Trial Order**”)

**AND UPON** the experts instructed by certain of the parties to the *McLaren* Proceedings wishing to co-operate to produce a consolidated dataset that they may use for the purpose of their economic analyses

**AND UPON** the parties to the *McLaren* Proceedings having agreed to make allowance for the time necessary for the participating experts to undertake that exercise, and requesting an extension to certain of the deadlines in the Directions to Trial Order by letter dated 30 October 2023

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. Paragraph 1 of the Directions to Trial Order be varied so that the *McLaren* Positive Position Statements shall be filed and served by 4pm on 13 February 2024.
2. Paragraph 2 of the Directions to Trial Order be varied so that the *McLaren* Negative Position Statements shall be filed and served by 4pm on 11 June 2024.
3. Paragraph 14(a) of the Directions to Trial Order be varied so that a Requesting Party shall notify the Receiving Party by making a Disclosure Request in respect of the *McLaren* Negative Position Statements by 4pm on 8 March 2024.
4. Paragraph 14(b) of the Directions to Trial Order be varied so that the Receiving Party shall comply with the Disclosure Request in respect of the *McLaren* Negative Position Statements by no later than 4pm on 11 April 2024, unless otherwise agreed or directed.
5. Costs in the case.
