# ORDER (DIRECTIONS)

**UPON** the applications for a Collective Proceedings Order ("CPO") brought by Ms Julie Hunter on 15 November 2022 (Case No. 1568/7/7/2022) and Mr Robert Hammond on 7 June 2023 (Case No: 1595/7/7/23)

**AND UPON** the ruling of the Tribunal of 5 February 2024 resolving the carriage dispute in favour of Mr Hammond

**AND UPON** the Competition Appeal Tribunal listing a certification hearing for 25 to 27 September 2024

# **IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

- 1. Mr Hammond shall serve an amended draft Claim Form by 4pm on 1 April 2024.
- 2. Amazon shall file and serve its response to Mr Hammond's CPO application by 4pm on 31 May 2024.
- Mr Hammond shall file and serve any reply to Amazon's response to Mr Hammond's CPO application, including any additional expert statements, if so advised, by 4pm on 26 July 2024.
- 4. The parties shall file and exchange skeleton arguments by 4pm on 13 September 2024.
- 5. The parties shall seek to agree the hearing and authorities bundles, in accordance with the Tribunal's Guide to Proceedings 2015 and Practice Direction of 25 February 2021, and Mr Hammond shall file the agreed bundles by 4pm on 9 September 2024.
- 6. Mr Hammond's application for a Collective Proceedings Order be heard on 25 to 27 September 2024 (with a two day time estimate and one day in held in reserve).
- 7. Costs in the case.
- 8. There is liberty to apply.
