CONSENT ORDER

UPON the Class Representative having agreed to Qualcomm's proposed amendments to its Re-Amended Defence dated 9 October 2023 in the form of the draft Re-Re-Amended Defence enclosed to Qualcomm's letter to the Class Representative dated 22 April 2025

AND UPON the Tribunal having received a letter from the solicitors for Qualcomm of 13 May 2025 enclosing the draft Re-Re-Amended Defence and requesting permission to file and serve their amended pleadings

AND HAVING REGARD TO the Tribunal's powers under Rule 53 of the Competition Appeal Tribunal Rules 2015

IT IS ORDERED BY CONSENT THAT:

1. Qualcomm has permission to amend its Re-Amended Defence in the form of the draft Re-Re-Amended Defence provided to the Class Representative on 22 April 2025. Qualcomm's Re-Re-Amended Defence shall be filed and served within 2 business days of this Order being made.

2. The Class Representative has permission to amend its Re-Amended Reply in response to the amendments introduced by the Re-Re-Amended Defence, which must be filed and served, if so advised, within 14 days of the service of the Class Representative's Reply Expert Report due on 6 June 2025.
3. Qualcomm shall pay the Class Representative's reasonable and proportionate costs of and occasioned by its amendments to the Re-Re-Amended Defence.
4. There shall be liberty to apply.
