ORDER

UPON the proposed collective proceedings under section 47B of the Competition Act 1998 (the **Act**) and r. 75 of the Competition Appeal Tribunal Rules 2015 (the **2015 Rules**) with case number 1733/7/7/25 commenced by Mr Roger Kaye KC and filed on 27 May 2025 (the **Kaye Proceedings**)

AND UPON the proposed collective proceedings under the Act and the Rules with case number 1733/7/7/25 commenced by Or Brook Class Representative Limited on 15 April 2025 (the **Brook Proceedings**) and filed on 15 April 2025

AND UPON the carriage hearing which took place in relation to the Kaye Proceedings and the Brook Proceedings on 6 and 7 October 2025

AND UPON the Proposed Class Representative's application dated 4 February 2026 seeking an order for an immediate stay of the Kaye Proceedings pursuant to r. 53(2)(k) of the 2015 Rules

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Kaye Proceedings be immediately stayed in their entirety.
2. Within 28 days of the judgment being handed down in relation to the certification of the Brook Proceedings or a collective proceedings order being granted (whichever is earlier), the Proposed Class Representative:
 - (a) shall, if the Brook Proceedings are certified, apply for the Kaye Proceedings to be withdrawn; or
 - (b) shall, if the Brook Proceedings are not certified, either:
 - (i) apply for further directions in relation to the Kaye Proceedings, including permission to lift the stay of the Kaye Proceedings; or
 - (ii) apply for the Kaye Proceedings to be withdrawn.
3. There be liberty to apply.
4. The issue of costs be deferred until after completion of the relevant action under paragraph 2 above.
