CONSENT ORDER

---

**UPON** the Reasoned Order of the President of the Tribunal dated 7 February 2024 permitting the Claimants to serve the Claim Form and associated documents (the **Claim Documents**) on the First, Second, Third, Fifth, Seventh and Eighth Defendants (the **Norwegian Defendants**) out of the jurisdiction pursuant to r. 31(2) of the Competition Appeal Tribunal Rules 2015 (the **Tribunal Rules**)

**AND UPON** the Claimants seeking to serve the Claim Documents on the Norwegian Defendants under the 1931 Convention between the UK and Norway regarding Legal Proceedings in Civil and Commercial Matters (the **1931 Convention**)

**AND UPON** each of the Norwegian Defendants challenging the validity of service under the 1931 Convention (the **CAT Service Challenges**)

**AND UPON** the Claimants subsequently serving the Claim Documents on the Norwegian Defendants under the Hague Service Convention and each Norwegian Defendant acknowledging such service

**AND UPON** the letter of the Registry of the Competition Appeal Tribunal dated 3 February 2025 deferring determination of the CAT Service Challenges to a later date (if necessary) and reserving the costs of the CAT Service Challenges until such time as they fell to be determined

**AND UPON** the Claimants and the Norwegian Defendants, by their solicitors, consenting to the terms of this order

**BY CONSENT IT IS ORDERED** that:

1. Each Norwegian Defendant shall withdraw its pending CAT Service Challenge.
2. There shall be no order as to costs in relation to the CAT Service Challenges.
