ORDER

UPON the collective proceedings against the Defendants which were certified by order of the Tribunal dated 23 May 2026 (the **CPO**)

AND UPON DAZN Group Limited (**DGL**) being a member of the Class, as defined in paragraphs 5 and 6 of the CPO, having not opted out of the Proceedings in accordance with paragraph 8 of the CPO and pursuant to r. 82 of the Competition Appeal Tribunal Rules (the **Rules**)

AND UPON DGL's request dated 11 June 2026 to opt out of the Proceedings pursuant to r. 82(2) of the Rules

AND UPON the letter from the Defendants' solicitors dated 17 June 2026 stating that DGL should be granted permission to opt out of the Proceedings

AND UPON the letter from the Class Representative's solicitors dated 17 June 2026 stating that the Class Representative did not oppose DGL's request

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. DGL is granted permission to opt out of the Proceedings.
2. The Class Representative shall amend the class register established by r. 83 of the Rules, so as to remove DGL.
3. There be no order as to costs.
4. There be liberty to apply.
