UPON the judgment of the Tribunal made on 21 April 2026, granting a collective proceedings order in case 1696/7/7/24

AND UPON the Reasoned Order of the Tribunal drawn on 28 May 2026 pursuant to which a one-day CMC has been listed for 4 December 2026 (the "CMC")

AND UPON the parties having agreed to the terms of this order, which sets out directions for the CMC, in draft form

IT IS ORDERED THAT

1. The Class Representative shall provide a draft CMC bundle index to the Defendants by 4pm on 9 November 2026.
2. A party that seeks to make any application(s) in connection with these proceedings to be heard at the CMC shall file and serve the respective application(s) by 4pm on 13 November 2026.
3. The Defendants shall provide comments on the draft CMC bundle index to the Class Representative by 4pm on 16 November 2026.
4. Where a party has made any application(s) in connection with these proceedings to be heard at the CMC, the other party shall file and serve any response(s) to such application(s) by 4pm on 20 November 2026.
5. The parties shall file an agreed agenda for the CMC by 4pm on 23 November 2026.
6. The Class Representative shall file an electronic version of an agreed CMC bundle by 4pm on 26 November 2026.
7. The parties shall file skeleton arguments for the CMC by 4pm on 27 November 2026.
8. The Class Representative shall file an electronic version of an agreed authorities bundle by 4pm on 30 November 2026.
9. There be liberty to apply.
