AND UPON the joint application of the Claimant and the Defendants

AND UPON the Claimant and the Defendants no longer being in dispute with each other having agreed to the terms set out in a confidential agreement, copies of which are held by the parties

AND UPON the Claimant and the Defendants having agreed to apply for the withdrawal of the Claimant’s claims in the Competition Appeal Tribunal Proceedings and claims in the High Court Proceedings after completion of conditions specified in the confidential agreement (the “terms”)

AND UPON the Defendants having undertaken to pay the share of Professor Iadh Ounis’ costs that may otherwise fall upon the Claimant.

AND HAVING REGARD TO rule 44(1)(a) of the Competition Appeal Tribunal Rules 2015

BY CONSENT IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Competition Appeal Tribunal Proceedings against the Defendants are dismissed.
2. There shall be no order as to costs.
