ORDER (CMC DIRECTIONS)

UPON the Proposed Class Representative's application filed on 20 June 2024, as amended and refiled on 3 July 2026, for a Collective Proceedings Order pursuant to section 47B of the Competition Act 1998 and Rule 75 of the Competition Appeal Tribunal Rules (S.I. 2015 No. 1648) (the **Tribunal Rules**) in respect of which a further CPO Hearing has been listed for 18 November 2026 (the **Renewed CPO Application**)

AND UPON claims for damages under section 47A of the Competition Act 1998 with case numbers 1632/5/7/24 and 1756/5/7/25 having been commenced by Asda Stores Limited and others and Tesco Stores Limited (the **Asda Proceedings** and the **Tesco Proceedings**; collectively with the Waterside Proceedings, the **Salmon Proceedings**)

AND UPON the listing of a joint Case Management Conference for the Salmon Proceedings to commence at 10.30am on 19 November 2026 with a time estimate of half a day (the **November CMC**)

AND UPON all parties to the Salmon Proceedings having agreed the following directions to the November CMC¹

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

APPLICATIONS

1. By 4pm on Monday 12 October 2026, the parties shall file and serve any application(s) they will ask the Tribunal to determine at the November CMC, including any accompanying evidence.
2. By 4pm on Monday 2 November 2026, the parties shall, if so advised, file and serve any evidence in response to any application(s) made pursuant to paragraph 1 above.

CMC AGENDA

3. The PCR/Claimants shall file an agenda for the November CMC which has been agreed between the parties by no later than 4pm on Wednesday 4 November 2026.

CMC SKELETON ARGUMENTS AND BUNDLES

4. The PCR/Claimants shall file with the Tribunal and serve on the Proposed Defendants/Defendants an electronic hearing bundle for the November CMC, the contents of which have been agreed between the parties by no later than 4pm on Monday 9 November 2026.

¹ Whilst all parties to the Salmon Proceedings have agreed these directions to the November CMC, attendance at the November CMC will depend on the outcome of the Renewed CPO Application. Unless the Tribunal directs otherwise at the Renewed CPO Application Hearing, parties to the Waterside Proceedings who are not also parties to the Asda Proceedings and/or Tesco Proceedings will only be required to attend the November CMC if the Renewed CPO Application is granted.

5. The parties shall file and exchange skeleton arguments for the November CMC by no later than 4pm on Wednesday 11 November 2026.
6. The PCR/Claimants shall file with the Tribunal and serve on the Proposed Defendants/Defendants an electronic version of the agreed bundle of relevant authorities by no later than 4pm on Friday 13 November 2026.
7. The parties shall file updated cross-referenced skeleton arguments by 4pm on Monday 16 November 2026.
8. Updated electronic hearing and authorities bundles, (and if requested by the Registry, hard copy versions of the same), are to be filed with the Tribunal by 4pm on Tuesday 17 November 2026.

GENERAL

9. There shall be liberty to apply.
