ORDER

UPON the application of the Class Representative dated 3 August 2026, enclosing a Redfern Schedule setting out the Class Representative's disclosure requests and the parties' respective positions on each of those requests (the "**Disclosure Application**")

AND UPON the Tribunal's Order made on 7 October 2025 (the "**Directions Order**"), as amended by the Order made on 26 January 2026 (the "**CMC3 Order**") and further amended by the Order made on 10 July 2026 (the "**Extensions Order**")

AND UPON the Tribunal listing a case management conference to take place on 18 September 2026 to determine the Disclosure Application (the "**Fourth CMC**")

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. By 4pm on 17 August 2026, the Defendant shall, if so advised, file and serve any response to the Class Representative's Disclosure Application.

2. By 4pm on 24 August 2026, the Class Representative shall, if so advised, file and serve any reply to the Defendant's response filed and served in accordance with paragraph 1 above.
3. The parties' solicitors shall meet by no later than 10 September 2026 with a view to narrowing the issues in dispute in relation to the Disclosure Application.
4. By 4pm on 11 September 2026, the parties shall file and serve electronically their respective skeleton arguments for the Fourth CMC.
5. By 11am on 14 September 2026, the parties shall file electronically and lodge two sets of hard copies of:
 - (a) the hearing bundle;
 - (b) the authorities bundle;
 - (c) skeleton arguments fully cross referenced to the bundles; and
 - (d) a further version of the Redfern Schedule (in A3 format) that identifies separately (i) the outstanding disclosure requests in dispute (as part 1 as the schedule) and (ii) the requests that have been agreed between the parties (as part 2 of the schedule).
6. Costs shall be in the case.
7. The parties have liberty to apply.
