CONSENT ORDER

UPON service of the Amended Collective Proceedings Claim Form and supporting documents on the Second Proposed Defendant, Scania CV AB (publ) on 21 August 2026

AND UPON the filing of the Second Proposed Defendant's acknowledgement of service on 1 September 2026 (the **Acknowledgement of Service**) indicating an intention to contest jurisdiction

AND UPON the deadline for the Second Proposed Defendant to file an application to contest jurisdiction being 15 September 2026 (the **Jurisdiction Challenge Deadline**)

AND UPON service of the Amended Collective Proceedings Claim Form and supporting documents on the First Proposed Defendant, Scania AB (publ), and the Third Proposed Defendant, Scania Deutschland GmbH (together, the **Foreign Proposed Defendants**)

AND UPON each Foreign Proposed Defendant having until 25 September 2026 to file an acknowledgement of service and until 14 days after filing an acknowledgement of service (which date will fall no later than 9 October 2026) to file any application to contest jurisdiction (the **Foreign Defendant Jurisdiction Challenge Deadline**)

AND UPON the Proposed Class Representative and the Proposed Defendants having agreed that the Jurisdiction Challenge Deadline should be extended in accordance with the terms of this Order

AND UPON the Second Proposed Defendant having explicitly stated that it has not waived its rights to object to the Tribunal's exercise of its jurisdiction to hear the Proposed Class Representative's claim against it in these proceedings

AND HAVING REGARD TO the Tribunal's powers under the Competition Appeal Tribunal Rules 2015, including its power under Rule 115(1) to regulate its own procedure

BY CONSENT it is ordered that:

1. The Jurisdiction Challenge Deadline is extended until the earlier of: (i) the Foreign Defendant Jurisdiction Challenge Deadline; and (ii) 9 October 2026.
2. Costs in the case.
3. There be liberty to apply.
