- 6. The appellant and respondent file and serve their skeleton arguments by 5pm on 24 November 2003.
- 7. If so advised, the interveners file and serve their skeleton arguments by 5pm on 26 November 2003.
- 8. The oral hearing of the appeal be fixed for 3 and 4 December 2003 at a time and location to be notified to the parties at a later date.
- 9. Costs reserved.
- 10. Liberty to apply.
