## **CONSENT ORDER**

**FURTHER TO** the Order of the Tribunal made on 29 September 2005

**AND UPON** the applicant having agreed to pay 60% of the respondent's costs incurred in relation to the interim relief proceedings and thereafter incurred in relation to the appeal proceedings to 25 March 2004, together with 100% of the OFT's costs in respect of the period 26 March 2004 to 14 October 2005 to include the costs of the OFT's in-house experts in respect of the OFT's Costs Report and the Supplementary Report, subject to no overheads and no profit element being included

**AND UPON** the OFT having agreed to accept £350,000 in full and final settlement of its costs, subject to interest at the judgment rate if remaining unpaid after 10 November 2005

# BY CONSENT, IT IS ORDERED THAT

1. Genzyme Limited pay £350,000 to the OFT in full and final settlement of the OFT's costs in this matter, such sum to be subject to the payment of interest at the judgment rate if such sum remains unpaid at the close of business on Thursday 10 November 2005.
