ORDER

UPON the Water Services Regulation Authority having agreed to pay £35,000 in full and final settlement of the experts and associated research costs ("the costs") incurred by Aquavitae (UK) Limited in proceedings before the Tribunal

AND UPON Aquavitae (UK) Limited having agreed to accept £35,000 in full and final settlement of the costs in proceedings before the Tribunal, subject to interest at the judgment rate if the costs remain unpaid seven days after the date of this order, and having withdrawn its application for a Contribution Order towards its remaining legal costs in these proceedings.

BY CONSENT IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The Water Services Regulation Authority pay £35,000 to Aquavitae (UK) Limited in full and final settlement of its legal costs in these proceedings, such sum to be subject to the payment of interest at the judgment rate if such sum remains unpaid seven days after the date of this order.
