- 4. Bristol Water Plc shall file and serve a Schedule of excisions made on the grounds of confidentiality to material on the respondent's files, in accordance with paragraph 13.26 of the Competition Appeal Tribunal Guide to Proceedings 2005, by 5:00 pm on 13 April 2006.
- 5. The respondent shall prepare bundles of documents appropriately excised in accordance with the Competition Appeal Tribunal Guide to proceedings for the appellant and the interveners respectively and shall, by 5:00pm on 26 April 2006, file at the Tribunal four copies of the bundle prepared for the appellant and serve on each of the appellant and the two interveners a copy of the bundle prepared for its respective use.
- 6. The preliminary hearing be listed for 10:00am on 9 June 2006.
- 7. There be permission to apply.
