ORDER

UPON considering the appellant's letter of 22 June 2007 informing the Tribunal that the Court of Appeal has granted it permission to appeal against the judgment of the Commercial Court in *English Welsh & Scottish Railway Ltd v E.ON UK Plc & Anor* [2007] EWHC 599 (Comm) (the "Appeal")
