ORDER

UPON the Appellant filing a Notice of Appeal on 4 September 2009 under rule 8 of the Competition Appeal Tribunal Rules 2003 (S.I. 2003 No. 1372) ("the appeal") alleging certain errors in the determination made by the Office of Communications ("OFCOM") contained in a document dated 6 July 2009 and entitled "Dispute about per-customer line transaction charges for Carrier Pre-Selection – Further statement" ("the Determination");

AND UPON OFCOM indicating in its letter of 6 October 2009 that it accepted that there was an error in the Determination in that OFCOM failed to consider the question of competitive distortion;

AND UPON OFCOM indicating further in a letter of 3 November 2009 that it proposed to redetermine the matters in dispute within four months of the date of this Order, after it had considered the question of competitive distortion;

AND UPON the parties indicating in correspondence that they have agreed a timetable for the procedure to be followed by OFCOM in carrying out the re-determination and that they are content for the appeal to be stayed

IT IS ORDERED BY CONSENT THAT:

- 1. The appeal be stayed until further order
- 2. The parties shall write to the Tribunal no later than 21 days following OFCOM's redetermination of the matters in dispute with their proposals for the further conduct of the appeal
- 3. Costs be reserved
- 4. There be liberty to apply
