CONSENT ORDER

UPON the Order of the Tribunal made in these proceedings on 19-20 September 2019 (**Disclosure Order**), in particular:

- (a) paragraph 10 which directed Volvo/Renault to disclose by list documents falling within categories O2 to O6 of Annex 1 to the Disclosure Order by 6 March 2020;
- (b) paragraph 11 which directed Volvo/Renault to disclose by list the management accounts containing information falling within categories O1(a)-(c), (e) set out in Annex 1 to the Disclosure Order by 6 March 2020; and

- (c) paragraph 12 which directed Volvo/Renault to provide a description, in relation to category O1(d) of Annex 1 to the DG Disclosure Order, of the cost allocation methodology applying during the years for which variable costs data is available on BNA and Partner (being 1 January 2003 to 30 December 2016 in the case of Volvo, and 1 January 2009 to 30 December 2016 in the case of Renault) by 6 March 2020

AND UPON the definitions adopted in the Disclosure Order applying for the purposes of this Order, except where otherwise stated

BY CONSENT IT IS ORDERED THAT

1. The time for Volvo/Renault's disclosure of the documents referred to in paragraph 10 of the Disclosure Order be extended to 30 April 2020.
2. The time for Volvo/Renault's disclosure of the documents referred to in paragraph 11 of the Disclosure Order be extended to 30 April 2020.
3. The time for Volvo/Renault to provide the description referred to in paragraph 12 of the Disclosure Order be extended to 30 April 2020.
4. The Parties shall have liberty to apply.
